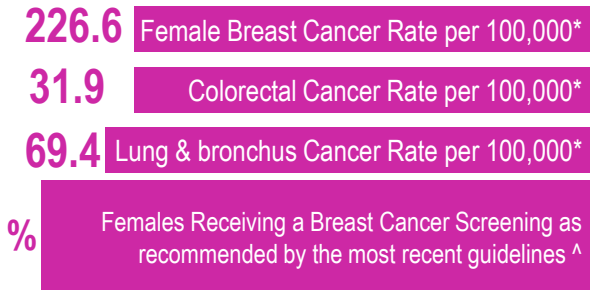
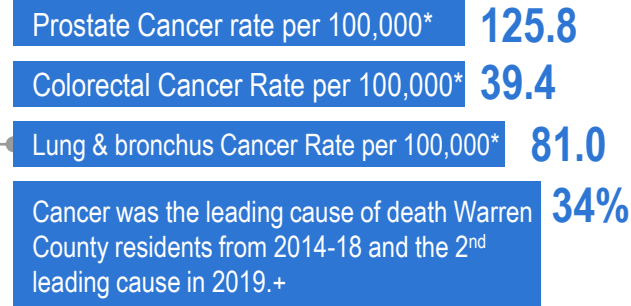
95 males in Warren County die each year from some form of cancer

78 females in Warren County die each year from some form of cancer.



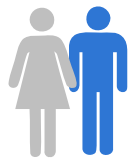

Adults in Warren County over age 18 are current smokers. Smoking is a leading cause of cancer in people.

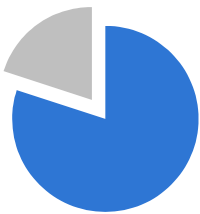


1 in 4

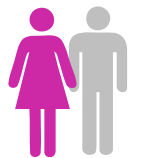


Females and males 50-64 yrs. old had a colorectal cancer screening as recommended by recent guidelines
