LOCAL LAW NO. 9 OF 2007

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF 2007
MODIFYING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR
ADMINISTRATOR OF WESTMOUNT HEALTH FACILITY**

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Warren, New York, as follows:

SECTION 1. Title. This Local Law shall be known as “A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 5 of 2007, Modifying Residency Requirements for Administrator of Westmount Health Facility”.

SECTION 2. Local Law Amending and/or Changed. This Local Law amends Local Law No. 5 of 2007, by amending the residency requirement in Section 3.

SECTION 3. Local Law No. 5 of 2007 Amended with Regard to amending Section 3 Residency Requirements. Section 3 is hereby amended to change the number of months for the Administrator to become a resident of Warren County as follows:

SECTION 3. Residency Requirements.

The provisions of Public Officers Law Section 3 requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen, or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall not prohibit a person from being appointed to the office of Administrator of Westmount Health Facility, Warren County, provided that such person becomes a resident of the County within twelve (12) [six (6)] months of the date of appointment.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately and upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.
