Planning to travel abroad?

In preparing to travel internationally, health care needs are often overlooked by travelers. It is not uncommon to receive conflicting information about what is recommended for prevention of disease and decreasing exposure risk.



DID YOU KNOW?

*Some countries require proof of certain immunizations for entry

*Not all “at risk” areas have government established health precautions

*There are a number of different governmental agencies and professional organizations providing information and recommendations on preventive health care and vaccination requirements. They include:

- The World Health Organization (WHO)
- The International Society of Travel Medicine (ISTM)
- The US Centers for Disease Control (CDC)

Therefore it is crucial to seek out professionals who stay abreast of current travel issues and the latest recommendations and requirements. It is essential for you to receive correct and up to date information and services prior to your travel.

We do not bill insurance, agencies or organizations.

We accept cash or check.

~ Payment in full must be provided at the time of the patient visit to the clinic. A detailed receipt will be provided for the patient to submit to their insurance should they wish to do so.

~ In the event the insurance company pays Warren County Health Services as opposed to the individual submitting the bill, Warren County will reimburse the patient the amount paid by the insurance. The patient will be responsible for the remainder of the visit cost not covered by insurance.
