Replacement of Double Barrel Culvert Where Marshall Brook Flows Under Olmstedville Road (County Route 19)

Warren County, in cooperation with the New York State Department of Transportation, is in the process of developing plans to replace the existing double-barrel culvert pipes that convey Marshall Brook under Olmstedville Road (County Route 19) near the intersection with David Road.

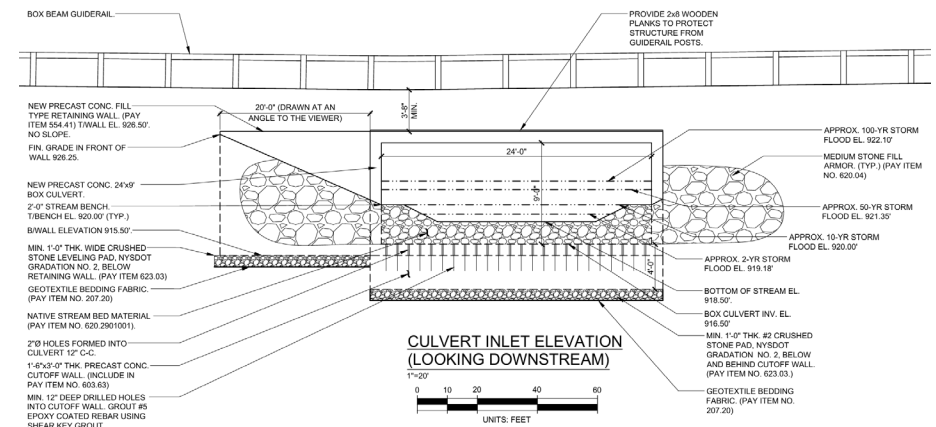
This state-funded project proposes to replace the existing culverts with a re-aligned 24-foot wide pre-cast concrete box culvert in accordance with state Environmental Conservation Department requirements. To complete this work, it will be necessary to temporarily close Olmstedville Road in the vicinity of the crossing. A detour will be in place during construction that will re-direct motorists to use US Route 9, NYS Routes 8, 28, and 28N, and Essex County Route 29 to bypass the construction zone.

Existing Culvert:



The estimated construction cost for this work is approximately \$1,900,000. Construction is anticipated to begin Summer 2026 and be completed by Fall 2026. This informational flyer is being distributed as part of the continuing efforts by the New York State Department of Transportation and the Warren County Department of Public Works to encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.
