

Warren County agencies part of new group confronting homelessness

Several Warren County agencies are part of a new organization, **Saratoga-North Country Continuum of Care**, that is tackling an issue that affects us all -- homelessness.

Along with community partners from around the region, Warren County is taking part in a campaign to replace misinformation about homelessness with acts, compassion, and data-driven solutions.

The Continuum of Care is a regional planning body serving Saratoga, Warren, Washington, and Hamilton counties, works to coordinate funding, services, and housing solutions with a goal of preventing and ending homelessness.

Warren County Office of Community Services, Warren County Department of Social Services and Warren County Administrator's Office are part of the organization.

"This campaign aims to shift the narrative from blame to understanding, from isolation to inclusion," said **Joan Spector, MST, Lead of the SNCCoC Planning Team**. "Homelessness stems from systemic challenges, not character flaws. When we embrace facts, we pave the way for effective solutions."
