



## 2026 Warren County "I Voted" Sticker Contest

**February 10, 2026** – The Warren County Board of Elections is pleased to announce the launch of the first ever "I Voted" Sticker Contest.

Any student, ages 5-18, who is residing in Warren County can participate. There will be 2 categories for entries, Kindergarten- 5<sup>th</sup> grade students are asked to create a "Future Voter" sticker and students 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade are asked to create an "I Voted" sticker. Participants are tasked with designing a unique image or logo for a 2-inch sticker that will be distributed at the general election this November and at subsequent elections. Included here are the contest rules and the entry sheets students can fill out and submit.

The Warren County Election Commissioners will select the top designs from each of the age groups. The selected finalists will be presented to the Warren County Board of Supervisors to determine the winners. One winner from each age group will be selected. Winners will be awarded at the July Board of Supervisors meeting, and their custom stickers will be handed out to Warren County voters beginning with the 2026 General Election.

Entries are due to the Board of Elections no later than **May 29th, 2026**. # 2026 Warren County "I Voted" Sticker Contest

## Design Requirements

All designs must include the phrase "Future Voter" for Kindergarten-5th and "I Voted" for 6th-12th in a legible manner. Winning designs will be printed as a 2-inch circle sticker.

Designs must not include, be based on, or derived from:

- third-party designs
- dates
- trademarks
- copyrighted images
- references to any candidates or political parties
- advocacy for or against any issue
- obscene, violent, or defamatory words or images

Participants are encouraged to explain their design and any symbolism found within the design on the Entry Form. All submitted entries may be modified, reproduced, and published at the discretion of the Warren County Board of Elections.

The Election Commissioners will use the following criteria to select finalists, which will be presented to the Warren County Board of Supervisors to determine the winners:

- Artistic skill and excellence shown in the design.
- Uniqueness of the design.
- The design's celebration of voting and / or civic pride.
- The participant followed the rules of the contest.

## Entry Requirements

All designs must be mailed or dropped off to the Warren County Board of Elections office no later than **May 29, 2026**.


