Mark the oval ☐ to the left of the name of your choice as such:

To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, mark the oval to the left of "Write-In" and print the name clearly in the box labeled "Write-In", staying within the box.

The number of choices is listed for each contest. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.

Any mark or writing outside the spaces provided for voting may void the entire ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot.



To Vote on a Question or Proposal, mark the Oval ☐ to the left of your choice.

If you make a mistake, or want to change your vote, ask a poll worker for a new ballot.

Amendment to Allow Olympic Sports Complex In Essex County on State Forest Preserve Land

Allows skiing and related trail facilities on state forest preserve land. The site is 1,039 acres. Requires State to add 2,500 acres of new forest land in Adirondack Park.

A "YES" vote authorizes new ski trails and related facilities in the Adirondack forest preserve.
