# John Pond - Clear Pond Loop

SIAMESE PONDS WILDERNESS - TOWNS OF JOHNSBURG and INDIAN LAKE, NY



- Difficulty:** Easy
- Length:** 4.7 mile loop
- Time to Complete:** 2-3 hours
- Trailhead Coordinates:** -74 13.26 43 44.02
- Markers:** Yellow; Red side trails
- Trail Notes:** This lovely, relatively flat loop hike passes through varied terrain to pretty Clear Pond, as well as John Pond, which has a lean-to. A short side trail about 0.7 miles south of John Pond leads to a small, early gravesite. Both trailheads are marked and you may start the loop from either direction. The trail register is at the south end of the loop.




### Directions and Parking:

From Route 9 in Warrensburg, turn left onto NY28 south and continue for 31.2 miles. Turn left onto Chamberlain Rd for 2.1 miles. Turn left onto Big Brook Rd for 1 mile. Turn left onto Starbuck Rd for 0.4 mile. Continue straight onto Lakeview Dr until it dead ends into Wilderness Ln. The north trailhead is at the intersection. For the south trailhead, turn right on Wilderness Ln, turn left onto the forest road and continue about a tenth of a mile to a small grass lot and the trail register.

### Things to Do Nearby:

Camp in the lean-to or one of several other primitive campsites in the area, or extend your hike or by continuing on the John Pond Crossover Trail into the Siamese Ponds Wilderness.
