SUNY ESF PACK DEMONSTRATION FOREST - TOWN OF WARRENSBURG, NY



- Surface Type:** Dirt/Gravel/Paved
- Difficulty:** Easy to Moderate
- Length:** Varies; Grandmother Trail is 1 mile
- Time to Complete:** Varies; 45 to 60 minutes for Grandmother Trail
- Trailhead Coordinates:** -73 48.26 43 32.90
- Trail Notes:** Pack Forest offers a variety of trails for hiking. The mostly flat one mile Grandmother's Tree Nature Trail winds through an old growth hemlock-white pine forest and contains one of New York's historic trees. Interpretive signs along the trail illustrate the various plants and animals that make up the ecosystem.



Directions and Parking:

Take the Northway to Exit 23. Turn left and then right onto US9. Go through Warrensburg, past the intersection with NYS 28. The entrance to Pack Forest will be 1/2 mile after this intersection on the left. Follow the entrance road and bear to the right to the parking area.

Things to Do Nearby:

Pack Forest contains many other recreational opportunities, including paddling, fishing, picknicking and mountain biking.
