


NONAGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT BY SUPERSECTOR








Key Observations & Comments Monthly Jobs Report

- Scale Albany Schen Troy Saratoga (434K) total employed workforce is over 7 times larger than Glens Falls MSA (56K)
- Similarities Glens Falls MSA and Albany Schen Troy MSA have very similar Industry Supersector percentages and composition. Both MSA's seeing growth in Leisure & Hospitality, Prof & Bus Services, Education & Health.
- Differences— Glens Falls has larger Manufacturing sector and smaller Education & Health sector. Gov't hiring increasing in Glens Falls, decreasing in Albany Schen Troy Saratoga.
- Overlap Because of proximity and adjoining nature of Glens Falls and AST MSA's there is considerable cross-migration

CAPITAL REGION IS NY'S 2ND FASTEST-GROWING REGION (2016/2017)








Metropolitan Statistical Area Map Boundaries – Capital Region








Proposed North Warren County Tour Sites


