**ACCEPTING PROPOSAL AND AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT WITH
TECHHEALTH, INC. FOR PHARMACY NETWORK VENDOR FOR
SELF-INSURED WORKERS' COMPENSATION PROGRAM (WC 39-12)**

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent has requested proposals for Pharmacy Network Vendor for Self-Insured Workers' Compensation Program (WC 39-12), and the Self-Insurance Administrator (upon recommendation from the Support Services Committee) has issued correspondence recommending the proposal from TechHealth, Inc., be accepted as providing the highest average savings for the County while meeting the terms and conditions of the specifications, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Purchasing Agent notify TechHealth, Inc. of the acceptance of its proposal, and be it further

RESOLVED, that Warren County enter into an agreement with TechHealth, Inc., 14025 Riveredge Drive, Suite 400, Tampa, FL 33637, to serve as the Pharmacy Network Vendor for Self-Insured Workers' Compensation Program, pursuant to the terms and provisions of the specifications (WC 39-12) and proposal, for a term commencing on October 1, 2012 and terminating on September 30, 2015, and the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute said agreement in the form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement may be continued and/or extended for one (1) further three (3) year term (October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2018), provided that: (a) the Purchasing Agent determines it continues to be in the County's interest to do so; (b) this authorization is not revoked; (c) that agreement terms are not changed; (d) an extension agreement is executed by the authorized County officer(s); and (e) and the County shall not be bound for such extended term unless each and every requirement previously set forth is fully met and/or completed by authorized County officer(s).
