

## **RESOLUTION NO. 188 OF 2015**

Resolution introduced by Supervisors Merlino, Conover, Wood, Taylor, Frasier, Dickinson, Simpson, Sokol and Vanselow

## AUTHORIZING ADIRONDACK RACE MANAGEMENT RUNNERS AND SUPPORT PERSONNEL ON THE WARREN COUNTY BIKEWAY AFTER SUNSET ON SEPTEMBER 19, 2015

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 2 of 1984 established certain rules and regulations for the use of various Warren County recreation facilities, which includes the Warren County Bikeway, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law contains a provision (Section 5) which states "The facilities shall be closed to any and all public use of any kind between the hours of sunset and sunrise, except as shall be otherwise provided by Resolution of the Warren County Board of Supervisors.", and

WHEREAS, a request has been made to the Superintendent of the Department of Public Works for the Adirondack Race Management runners and support personnel to access the Warren County Bikeway for four and one half (4<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) hours (between 5:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.) on September 19, 2015, and in subsequent years, in order to conduct a Flashlight - 5K race, from the bikeway intersection with Ft. George Road to Old Military Road and return to Ft. George Road, Lake George, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Adirondack Race Management runners and support personnel to access the Warren County Bikeway for four and one half (4½) hours (between 5:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.) on September 19, 2015, and in subsequent years, in order to conduct a Flashlight - 5K race, from the bikeway intersection with Ft. George Road to Old Military Road and return to Ft. George Road, Lake George, provided the following conditions are met: (1) execution of a County Facility Use Permit by all parties; (2) proof of adequate and necessary insurance to cover the activity, and if necessary, the naming of Warren County as an additional insured; (3) that residents abutting this section of the Bikeway be informed of the activity; (4) participants/runners in the event will execute a release/waiver in favor of Warren County to the extent practicable; and (5) Adirondack Race Management is responsible for determining and providing adequate nighttime lighting along the Warren County Bikeway.
