AUTHORIZING THE AIRPORT MANAGER TO EXECUTE A FEDERAL CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION ("CATEX") FORM WITH REGARD TO FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL APPROVAL PROCESS FOR A FUTURE PAVEMENT CRACK SEALING AND REPAIR PROJECT ANTICIPATED FOR 2016

WHEREAS, the Airport Manager has advised that he has prepared an application to the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") for a categorical exclusion ("CATEX") with regard to FAA environmental approval process for a future pavement crack sealing and repair project anticipated for 2016 at the Floyd Bennett Memorial Airport and is requesting authorization to execute the CATEX form and submit it to the FAA, now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, that the Warren County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Airport Manager

to execute the CATEX form and submit the CATEX application to the FAA with regard to the FAA environmental approval process for a future pavement crack sealing and repair project anticipated for 2016 at the Floyd Bennett Memorial Airport.
