

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY SUPERVISORS MONTESI, GERAGHTY, GIRARD, BROCK, SIMPSON, VANSELOW, BRAYMER, SEEBER AND MACDONALD

AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH POWERPHONE FOR TOTAL RESPONSE PROTOCOL SOFTWARE AND TRAINING FOR THE WARREN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE COMMUNICATIONS CENTER

WHEREAS, the Warren County Sheriff's Office has requested approval to enter into an agreement with PowerPhone, 1321 Boston Post Road, Madison, Connecticut 06443, for the purchase of total response integrated protocol software and training for a total amount not to exceed Seventy-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$79,372) for a term commencing upon execution by both parties and continuing unless terminated by either party with or without cause, and

WHEREAS, the Total Response software will streamline the emergency protocol and call handling process to create consistency, efficiency and speed, as well as supporting the call takers and dispatchers,

and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee has approved the request for an agreement with PowerPhone as outlined above, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors be, and hereby is, authorized to execute an agreement with PowerPhone for the purchase of total response integrated protocol software and training for a total amount not to exceed Seventy-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$79,372) for a term commencing upon execution by both parties and continuing unless terminated by either party with or without cause, in a form approved by the County Attorney, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the funds shall be expended from Budget Code A.3020.4033 250, Sheriff's 911 Center, 2016-2017 PSAP Grant, Technical Equipment.
