Mr. McDevitt called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m. Mr. McDevitt continued with the agenda regarding the review and recommendation of approval of the 2019 Audited Financial Statements. Mr. Bartholomew advises that recommendation from the full Board is need for approval of the 2019 Audited Financial Statements. He indicates that the audit was completed and submitted showing a clean audit in terms of no audit findings involved with no management letter being issued. He points out the total amount of net assets for 2019 being \$1,736,965 and 2018 the total net assets was \$1,729,528. He continues with the audit and the breakdown of the revenues showing 2019 and 2018 being very similar with just a little over a \$100 difference. He advises that you breakout the expenses and the net assets for both years are about the same. He states that the biggest change of the audit shows on page 5 when the LDC amended the Investment Policy and went out to bid to area banks for a certificate of deposit. The bids came back and the LDC awarded the highest bid to TD Bank at 2.3% for a certificate of deposit for one year. He explains that the comparison on page 5 will show that there is a reduction in cash, as putting this into a certificate of deposit eliminates that from cash with the total in the certificate of deposit being \$511,000. Mr. Bartholomew advises that in going forward the LDC

is going back out to bid for continuation with the area banks to look at money market as well as certificates of deposits, which will be reported back at the next board meeting on how to proceed. He continues with the audit and advises that the summary sheet on page 17 shows the auditor's results, which reflects no area of weakness or deficiencies reports, a low risk auditee and no audit findings with regard to the prior year financial statements.

Mr. McDevitt asked for a motion to approve the 2019 Audited Financial Statements. Motion made by Mr. Simpson and seconded by Mr. Leggett, and carried unanimously.

As there was no further business to come before the Audit/Finance Committee, motion was made by Mr. Leggett to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Simpson, and carried unanimously. Mr. McDevitt adjourned the meeting at 9:15 a.m.

Mr. Bartholomew continues with the agenda for review and approval of various By-Laws, policies and procedures. He indicates that there were no changes with the policies adopted this He advises that the Investment Policy was changed last year for the various year.

recommendations from the auditors as well as changes being made to the Whistleblower Policy to conform with the new State Legislation. He indicates that the second item to be reviewed would be the Investment Policy within the next meeting to review the percentage rates received from area banks. He continues with the Procurement Policy and indicates no changes being made to that particular policy. He states that also included is the Audit Contract, which is \$6,000 and the contract between the EDC (Economic Development Corporation) and LDC. He advises that as part of the LDC reporting the General Counsel will be Mary Kissane, Warren County Attorney, and Robert Terwilliger, Warren County First Assistant Attorney to assist the LDC. He continues with the banking institutions being Glens Falls National and TD Bank, which is the bank associated with the certificate of deposit as well as Harris Beach, as Special Counsel. He explains that any work conducted by Harris Beach is subject to a contract being approved by the LDC. He continues to advise that the LDC does not own any real property or personal property. Chairman McDevitt called the meeting to order. He asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the February 4, 2020 Special Board meeting and the February 24, 2020 meeting. Motion made by Director Merlino and seconded by Director Leggett. Motion carried unanimously.

Chairman McDevitt continued with the agenda regarding the review and approval of the February 2020 Financial Statements. Mr. Bartholomew begins with the financial report and reflects nothing out of the ordinary and indicates that at the next Board meeting confirmation that the LDC will be transferring the \$10,000 to the Warren County Planning Department as part of the Affordable Housing Study with the EDC (Economic Development Corporation) approving the transfer and the monies will be sent from the EDC to appropriate budget line to Warren County in the total amount of \$20,000. He advises that last year the LDC undertook an effort to work with some of the loan recipients that needed some additional assistance and as a result last

year there were four loans that were paid off including the Dome, Friends Lake Inn, Seamless Gutters, and Celtic Treasurers. He advises that out of eight of the existing loans the LDC has received four inquiries relative to their financial status due to their temporary closure and he would propose to work with the LDC and Chairman McDevitt to develop a proposal and criteria for consideration in providing relief for the individual loan recipients. He explains that he would request a Special Meeting to discuss the details in further detail and develop the criteria as soon as possible.

Director Simpson agrees with Mr. Bartholomew and advises that the criteria need to be expedited in order to work with these businesses as soon as possible.

Director Merlino agrees with Director Simpson and believes they should consider a 3 month deferment on these loans to help these businesses.

Chairman McDevitt asked for a motion to approve the February 2020 Financial Statements. Motion was made by Director Merlino and seconded by Director Simpson. The following motion was unanimously carried:

RESOLVED, that the Warren County Local Development Corporation ("LDC") hereby approves the Financial Report for February 2020.

Director Leggett questions if the loans that were paid last year, if the LDC worked with Seamless Gutter when they had a fire and Mr. Bartholomew confirmed. He indicates that working with the Chairman to have some loan reprieve is a wonderful idea.

Supervisor Braymer advises that she is glad that this discussion is taking place and asks if there is anything else that can be done such as utility and rent payments being delayed. Mr. Bartholomew advises that the LDC has to develop criteria on how to go about helping these businesses. He indicates that he has been working with the State as well as local banks for certain mortgages that may be extended out. He advises that he is hopeful to have a Special Meeting within the next week for approval on the process of helping these businesses.

Chairman McDevitt continued with the agenda regarding the review of the Loan Portfolio and Mr. Bartholomew states that an executive session would not be necessary at this time.

As there was no further business to come before the LDC Board, motion was made by Director Merlino to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Director Leggett, and carried unanimously.
