Law Enforcement Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training/TA	The Office of Community Services facilitated an application on behalf of Warren and Washington Counties for a Law Enforcement Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training and technical assistance initiative. We were approved and four LE agencies are participating: Warren County Sheriff's Office; Glens Falls Police Department; Washington County Sheriff's Office; and Hudson Falls Police Department. There is a built-in train-the-trainer, for future sustainability/training capacity. There is financial reimbursement for road patrol officers to take the week-long CIT training course. We recently participated in a two-day kick off meeting in Clifton Park and are forming a Steering Committee to oversee planning and implementation of the initiative. The Steering Committee includes representation from each of the law enforcement agencies involved, the Office of Community Services, and peers—through People USA.	
Mental Health First Aid for Higher Education award – SUNY ADK	The Office of Community Services applied for a pilot project through the NYS Conference of Mental Hygiene Directors (CLMHD) for Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) for Higher Education to be implemented on the SUNY ADK campuses—including Queensbury and Wilton. We were successful in getting an award, and are working with CLMHD and SUNY ADK on implementation. The project also includes harm reduction activities and training, in addition to the MHFA curriculum.	
NYS OMH Hospital and Community Connections Initiative	The NYS Office of Mental Health is facilitating regional meetings to discuss supporting individuals in our community in their transitions in and out of inpatient hospital settings. There is a focus on strengthening relationships, communication, coordination, etc., between inpatient and outpatient providers.	
Washington County Mental Health Court	Judge Hobbs is developing a Mental Health Court in Washington County. He is setting up planning groups and meetings for development of this specialty court.
