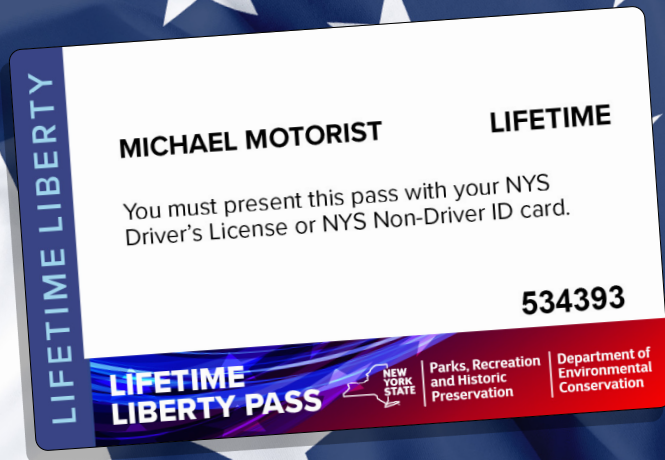

B. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Applicant must be a New York State Resident to receive a Lifetime Liberty Pass. The Client ID number submitted with your order will be used to verify the residency requirement.

C. NYS VETERANS - Must provide proof of Release or Discharge under other than dishonorable conditions. Acceptable proofs are:

- A photo/copy of your NY State DMV ID with Veteran status designation
- A U.S. Department of Defense Form DD-214 that indicates an honorable discharge
- A U.S. Department of Defense Form DD-215 that indicates an honorable discharge
- An NGB Form 22 that indicates an honorable discharge
- If discharged before January 1, 1950, an Honorable Discharge form WD AGO 53, WD AGO 55, WD AGO 53-55, NAVPERS 553, NAVMC 78PD, NAVCG 553, or an Enlisted Separation Paper
- A Certification of Military Service (NA FORM 13038) that indicates a discharge that is either honorable or under honorable conditions

* Any of the above documents can be submitted with a NYS Veterans Benefits Decision Letter, from the NYS Department of Veterans' Services, verifying the Veteran meets the character of discharge requirements.
